Your Face..."

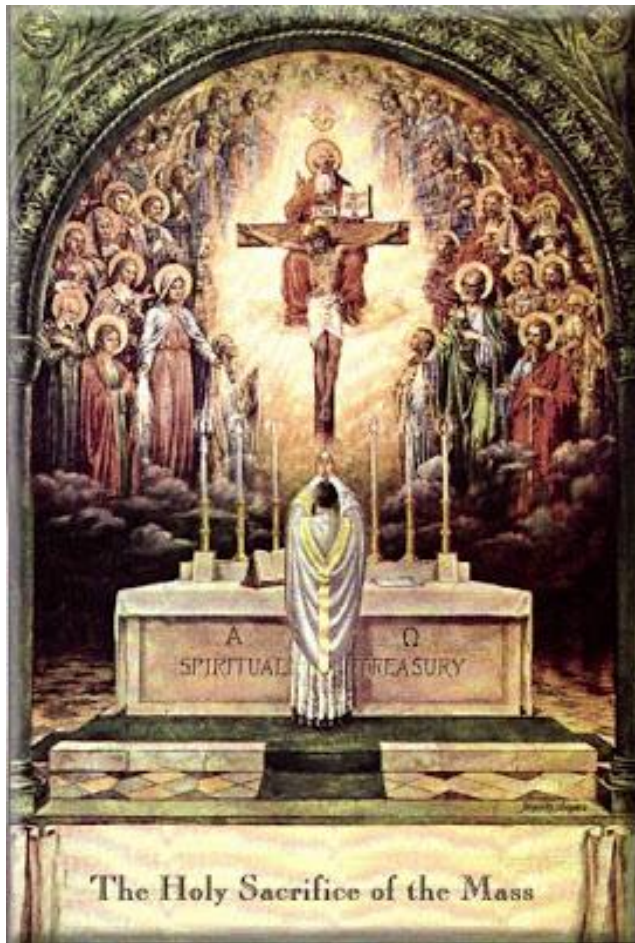
Eternal Father, I offer You
